Bungii and Goodwill Partner on Deliveries

Washington, DC: Goodwill of Greater Washington (Goodwill) has partnered with <u>Bungii</u> to provide a simple solution for store-to-home delivery. Now, Goodwill customers can get their large in-store purchases home easier than ever before by downloading the app and requesting a delivery.

Bungii is an app based delivery service that puts a pickup truck and a driver at your fingertips. Whether you are buying a couch off of craigslist, buying a mattress from the store, or just trying to bring some boxes to storage, Bungii can do it all.

Our mission is simple: we believe providing an easy way to get stuff around town makes life easier for everyone. Request a delivery on-demand, or schedule your delivery in advance to connect with a local, Bungii certified driver.

Within 24 hours of a Goodwill customer scheduling a delivery from a Goodwill store on the Bungii app, a certified, licensed and insured driver will pick up the merchandise from the store where it was purchased and deliver it to the customer's desired location. Cost is dependent upon the size of the item being delivered and the distance to delivery. A cost estimate will be provided to the customer through the app before the customer confirms the delivery. The customer simply pays by attaching a credit card to their account profile on the Bungii app.

Effective October 1st, all Goodwill of Greater Washington stores will begin promoting the Bungii app for home deliveries. While customers can still hire a delivery company of their choice, Bungii will become the exclusive, preferred home delivery partner for Goodwill of Greater Washington stores.

App users can download Bungii from the iTunes app store and through Google Play.

Goodwill of Greater Washington's mission is to transform lives and communities through the power of education and employment.

Goodwill offers free job training programs in hospitality, unarmed security, and healthcare administration, as well as other supportive services. Goodwill also operates an adult charter high school: The Goodwill Excel Center, which is the only adult charter high school in DC to help students earn a high school diploma rather than a GED.
