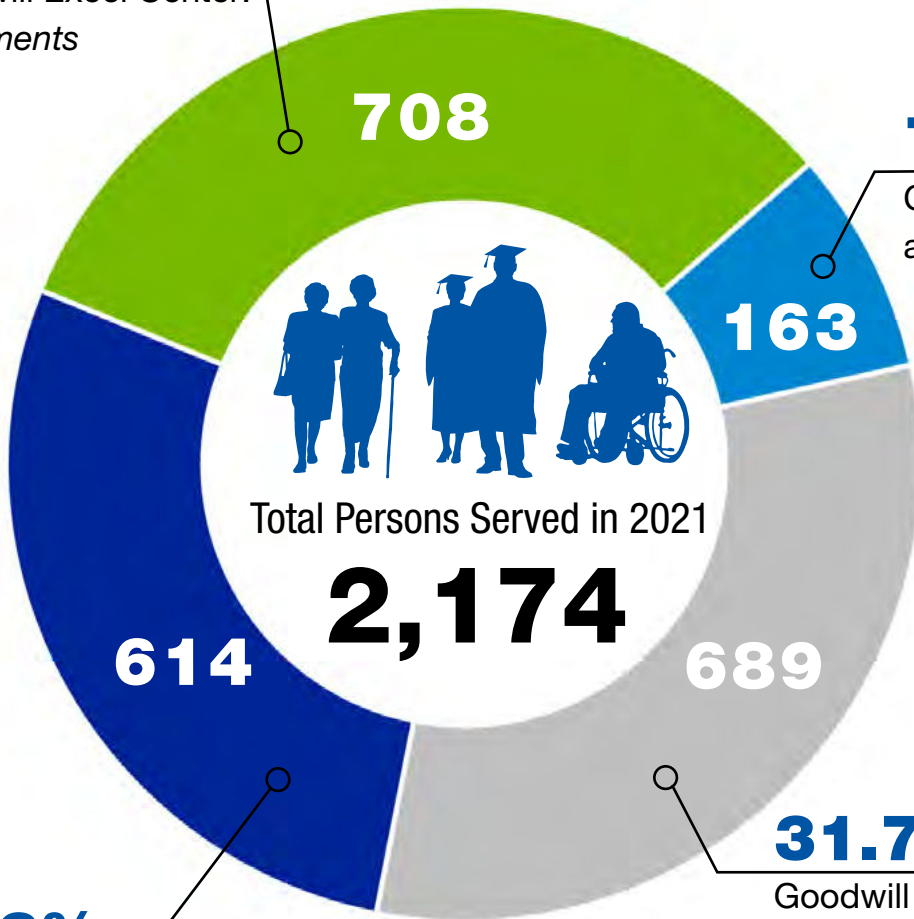

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT SERVICES



- Number of associates who received workforce development and coaching services in 2021:

CONTRACTS



- The contracts division employed 197 people.
- Number of contract sites – 9 federal, 4 Best Kept Buildings
- Total square footage cleaned by custodial team – 3 million square feet

- 78.92% of all labor hours at contract sites were performed by persons with disabilities
- The average hourly wage with benefits for all contracts employees as of 12/31/21 was \$20.28/hour.

RETAIL AND DONATED GOODS



- Goodwill of Greater Washington operated 21 retail stores.
- Goodwill's retail stores and donation centers employed 694 people at the end of 2021.
- 1,861,235 purchases were made at Goodwill of Greater Washington retail stores. 79,647 purchases were made online.

- Goodwill of Greater Washington received 922,806 confirmed donations of household goods.
- Donations to Goodwill of Greater Washington kept more than 36,912,000 pounds of material out of area landfills.
